

Licenses

Automobile - License plate stickers for all vehicles may be purchased over the counter at all local banks. The local banks also provide titles and transfers.

Driver - Driver's license exams or renewals are given at the Senior Center, located at 904 West Jourdan, on the first and third Wednesdays of each month. The office is open from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Within 10 days of changing addresses or names, persons must contact the bureau. There is a \$5 fee for a new driver's license for those that are 18, 19 and 20 and for those needing duplicate licenses. There is also a \$4 charge for State of Illinois identification cards. There is a \$12 fee for the transfer of a car title and a \$13 fee for a new title. Marriage - Marriage licenses are available at the county clerk's office, located in the Jasper County Courthouse. Office hours are 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Persons 16 and 17 years of age must have parental consent of both natural parents, with the consent being signed in the county clerk's office. Those 16 years of age and under cannot receive a marriage license even with parental consent. There is a \$15 fee and 24-hour waiting period. The marriage license is valid for 60 days from date of issue. No blood test is required in that state of Illinois. A marriage must take

place within the county in which the license is obtained. For more information, call 783-3124.

Voter Registration

To register to vote, one must be at least 18 years of age and be a resident of the county for at least 30 days prior to any upcoming election.

Registration can take place at the County Clerk's office or by a deputy registrar. All precinct committeemen are deputy registrars, some civic groups have deputy registrars as part of their organization and certain other registrars may be appointed at the discretion of the County Clerk. The new National Voter Registration Act will allow registration at many public offices, public aid, driver's license facilities, etc.

Two forms of identification are required to register. One of the ID's must have the registrant's current address.

Voter registration must be changed if the voter moves. Re-registration is required if the voter's name is changed by marriage or any other change in name.
